**Saison Dupont** 6.5% abv A classic Belgian farmhouse ale. This is a beautifully balanced complex beer that is hoppy with a refreshing peppery fruitiness and long, dry finish. 8.00 (11.2 oz)

**Petrus Aged Pale Ale** 7.3% abv Old golden hued and aged in wood for 24-30 months. Oaky aroma with hints of sherry and fruit, and sourness in the finish. 8.00 (11.2 oz)

**St. Bernardus Abt 12 Abbey Ale** 10% abv A dark ivory colored beer with a high fermentation, soft aroma and a very fruity flavor. This well balanced ale is the show piece of the brewery in West Flanders. 9.00 (11.2 oz)

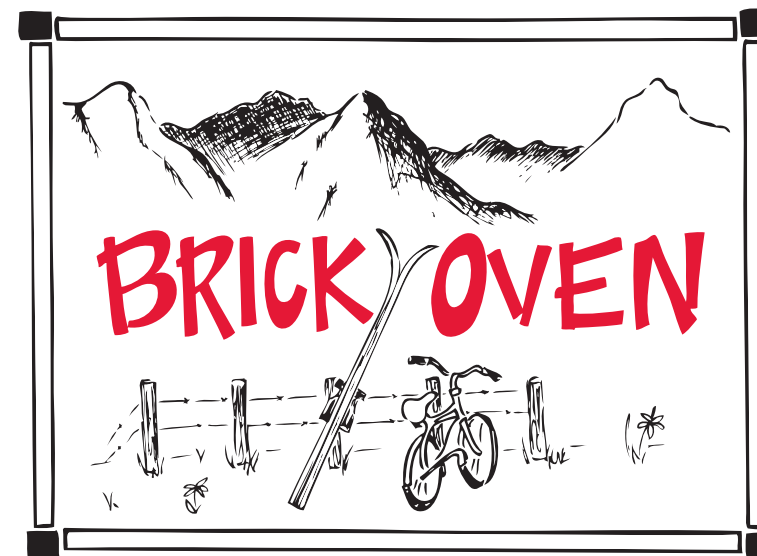

# Cold Drafts

**New Belgium Sunshine Wheat (filtered)** 4.8% abv Swirls in the mouth with ripples of coriander and orange peel tartness, settling nicely into a tranquil sea of apple and honey tones. This is a good choice for beginners (Coors drinkers) who want to broaden their horizons. Served with a slice of orange. 4.00

**Palisade Brewing Laid Back Blonde** 5.0% abv Our lightest craft beer! Not sacrificing flavor for volume, this blonde beauty is crisp and clean finishing with slightly fruity notes and a malty finish. 4.00

**Avery White Rascal (unfiltered)** 5.6% abv A truly authentic Belgian style wheat or “white” ale, this rascal is unfiltered and cleverly spiced with coriander and curacao orange peel producing a refreshingly fruity thirst quencher. 4.00

**Trumer Pilsner** 4.4% abv Started in Salzburg in 1601 and relocated to Berkeley, CA in 2004. True to style, not too hoppy. A remarkable crisp German pils brewed in the U.S., available fresh in Colorado with no journey across the Atlantic. 4.00

**New Belgium Fat Tire Amber Ale** 5.3% abv Features a Belgian style balance of malt and hops- bready but with a lighter yank twist. It’s a tasty cult beer; a light flash of hops tames the malt. 4.00

**Deschutes Mirror Pond Pale Ale** 5.0% abv A classic American pale ale, Mirror Pond uses generous quantities of Cascade hops, offering a lush floral aroma with a balanced malt body. This is a pale ale that drinks more like an IPA and is a good introduction to more serious, “big” beers. Gold medal: 1994 GABF American Pale Ale 4.00

**Winter Seasonal Ale** (abv varies) Winter is a thirsty season, one for which beer is tailor made. We feature winter seasonals from our favorite brewers. Ask your server/bartender about today’s features. 4.50

**Deschutes Green Lakes Organic Ale** 5.2% abv Brewed with five types of 100% organic malted barley and balanced with Liberty and Sterling hops. It is easy to drink, easy on the environment and downright delicious. 4.50

**Stone IPA** 6.9% abv Brewed in true IPA style, high in alcohol and hops. Stone IPA has a huge hop aroma, deep golden color, and medium body. Despite being massive on the palate, it is wonderfully balanced and refreshing for a big beer. 5.50

**Avery IPA** 6.3% abv In the 1700’s a crafty brewer discovered that a healthy dose of hops and an increased alcohol content preserved his ales during the long voyage to India to quench the thirst of British troops. Sniff & sip to truly appreciate the citrusy floral bouquet and rich malty finish of this delectable IPA. Gold medal: 2003 GABF American Strong Ale 4.00

**Sierra Nevada Porter** 5.6%abv Dark and rich, this medium-bodied ale is creamy, smooth and malty with hints of caramel, chocolate and coffee coming from a blend of deep-roasted barley malts. 4.00

**Russian River Damnation Belgian Style Strong Golden Ale** 7.0% abv Extraordinary aromas of banana and pear with mouth filling flavors of sweet malt and earthy hops. The lingering finish is dry and slightly bitter but very smooth. Gold medal: 1999 GABF Belgian Style Ale 6.00

## Nitrogen tapped beer

*These beers are characterized by creamy long-lasting, dense heads, velvety mouth feel and supreme drinkability.*

**Left Hand Nitro Milk Stout** 6.0%abv Dark, sweet and creamy with hints of chocolate, coffee and vanilla. Roasted malt makes this stout rich and hearty yet very smooth and thin. Silver Medal: 2008 GABF Sweet Stout 5.50

**Left Hand Nitro Sawtooth Ale** 4.4% abv An American style ESB, medium body and maltiness tapped with nitrogen for a rich, dense head - think British pub ale. Sessionable and unpretentious. 5.00

**Deschutes Nitro Obsidian Stout** 6.4%abv This stout is as black as midnight with a dark head. It has a deep, chocolate aroma, wonderfully complex and clean. Obsidian is hoppy and bitter in the mouth, with a great roasted finish. 5.00

**Tripel Karmeliet** 8% abv Inspired by the 3 grain beer brewed in the 1600s. Made from raw and malted barley, wheat and oats. Golden to bronze with a creamy head; great finesse and complexity. Restrained hoppiness, generous spicing and fruity banana and vanilla character from the house yeast. 8.00

**New Belgium Lips of Faith Series** 6-10% abv Ask your server/bartender which of these imaginative brews is on tap. They are New Belgium’s small batch creations, made without rules or boundaries. Often a sour beer, always interesting and satisfying. 6.00-8.00

**Imperial IPA** ~8.5-10% abv Massive hop bombs from Great Divide, Avery and others. Resinous, piney and hints of grapefruit and alcohol. 6.00-9.00

**Great Divide Yeti Imperial Stout** 9.5% abv An onslaught for the senses. It starts with big, roasty malt flavor that gives way to rich caramel and toffee notes. A bold hop character from an enormous quantity of American hops. We will rotate this beer with Espresso Oak Aged Yeti, and Chocolate Oak Aged Yeti. Silver medal: 2009 GABF Imperial Stout 6.50

**Avery Hog Heaven Barley Wine Style Ale** 9.2% abv This dangerously drinkable garnet beauty is a hop lover’s delight. The intense dry hop nose and the alcohol content are perfectly balanced for a caramel candy like malt finish. 6.50

## Beer Knowledge

**Cask ale** Unfiltered and unpasteurized beer that is conditioned and served from a cask without additional nitrogen or carbon dioxide pressure. The Ale is allowed to mature naturally creating a gentle, natural CO<sub>2</sub> carbonation that allows malt and hop flavors to develop, resulting in a richer tasting drink with more character than standard keg beers. Cask ale is the original method of brewing, storing and serving beer. abv and price vary. ASK YOUR SERVER WHAT’S ON CASK!

**Belgian Blonde Ale** A moderate strength golden ale, a light variation on pale ale. A light hop nose, sweet pils malt character with Belgium yeast strains for a dry finish.

**Pale Ale** Pale Ale is a variety of British ale that is dry in character and tends to be more hoppy and higher in alcohol than its relative, English Bitter.

**India Pale Ale** A special style of pale ale that has a more hoppy flavor, aroma and bitterness, as well as a higher alcohol content; this is to ensure freshness for the sea voyage from the British isles around the cape of Africa to the colonies in India.

**Sour Beer** Characterized by an acidic, tart, sour taste- beers may have a varying degree of sourness in their character. Souring may be achieved through unique wild yeast strains such as *brettanomyces lambicus* or it may be achieved through bacteria, most commonly *lactobacillus*.

**Strong Ale** A high alcohol version of pale ale with more body and sweetness. These beers are often aged longer which softens the bitterness of the hops.

**Stout** A black ale that owes its character to roasted barley and a high hop rate.

**Imperial Stout** A robust and stronger version of a dry stout. With the high hop and alcohol rate this style can be aged many months thus giving the flavor even more complexity.

**Porter** A dark ale whose character, unlike a stout, comes from dark malts not roasted barley, they are generally medium-bodied with varying degrees of sweetness and hops.

**Barley Wine** A golden or copper colored ale with high alcoholic strength and a full bodied well-aged character, the natural sweetness is usually balanced with high hop bitterness.

**Belgian White Beer** Brewed with unmalted wheat, malted barley and sometimes oats, the style is enhanced by the addition of coriander seed and curacao (or orange peel).

**Lager** A beer brewed with bottom-fermenting types of yeast at temperatures below 50 degrees F (10 C). The German word lager means “to store”. Some styles are lagered for over 3 months.

**Pilsener** A pale, golden lager that is well-carbonated, bitter and dry with an accent on the rich malt.
